- Parent How can we get the word out for PTO meetings in the future
  - The most effective method for Dr. B is calling parents via robocall

#### Presentation:

- Dr. Folden-Handley (Dr. Hyphen) PBIS (Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports)
  - o PBIS is about teaching expectations to our students so they can grow academically and as people
  - There is a lot of data gathering to determine where we need to focus
  - Helps eliminate assumptions by setting clear expectations and hold kids accountable to meeting those expectations
  - Helps develop self-respect, self-discipline, and self-control
  - School is the student's place of business and their job (expectations) changes every time they go from one class to another, but e3 doesn't change
  - First two years spent working on e3 and gathering data
  - o Monthly PBIS newsletter for the teachers with information and strategies
  - Example: Issue with students being tardy to their first class (even though they are in the school)
    - Students had to be taught that being on time meant being in class prior to 8:10
    - We had to eliminate the issues out of the student's control to address the true root causes
    - Tardy numbers dropped significantly after being addressed
  - Now we are focusing on specific problem behaviors and rewarding good behaviors
  - PBIS sponsored e3 door competition
