## Parking Instructions for Graduation, May 26

We want graduation to be an enjoyable night for all. We do not want parking to be an issue but due to the amount of people who will be coming, we want you to keep some things in mind to help it stay smooth.

- 1. There will be no thru traffic on Tiger Trail beginning at 5pm
- 2. The senior and junior lots are available for parking for graduation. You will need to enter from Hwy 54 or Lafayette Avenue. *You should not enter from Hood Avenue*.
- 3. Handicapped Parking will be available in the upper stadium parking lot on the home side.

  Anyone using handicapped parking should enter from Hood Avenue. You will only be allowed to the handicapped parking with a handicapped sticker or pass issued by the school. Graduating seniors will get instructions about passes at graduation practice on Thursday, May 25. Non-handicapped family members may sit with handicapped members but will need to bring bag chairs to ensure seating on the home side (space permitting). Unfortunately, there are not benches available in the handicapped section on the home side. They are available on the visitor's side.

There are a few (5) handicapped parking spots available near the visitor side in the senior parking lot. To get to those, you will not want to come from Hood Avenue as you will be blocked.

There is handicapped seating on both sides of the stadium, home and visitor. However, if you use the visitor side, you will probably not be able to park in a handicapped spot.
