Ask the appropriate teacher(s) to complete a recommendation form if required. These will be returned to the AP teacher(s) by the recommending teacher(s). Forms are on the FCHS website.
Complete any placement tests or timed writing samples as indicated on the front of this application. Pay close attention to scheduled dates!
