Talking and singing to him or her as a baby, helping him or her learn to talk, reading bedtime stories, that all helped your child begin to understand how sounds. letters and words fit together to make meaning. Now that your child is in elementary school, you may think reading instruction is best left to his or her teachers. But that's not so! Studies show that the more parents support reading skills at home, the better readers their children become.

There are 5 key skills that most teachers focus on. You can help support them everyday, No special tools or training required!

Phonemic Awareness: Learning the sounds of speech

Phonics: Sounding it out

Fluency: Practice makes perfect

Vocabulary: exploring the world through words

Comprehension: Opening doors to learning
