In our classroom, we support reading on a daily basis by teaching sight words and practicing reading fluency. Our goal is for students to learn at least 200 sight words and read at a rate of 69 words per minute by the end of the year.

- Our class web page has links to family friendly websites to extend reading skills.
- Provide daily homework that supports reading fluency and number recognition.
