

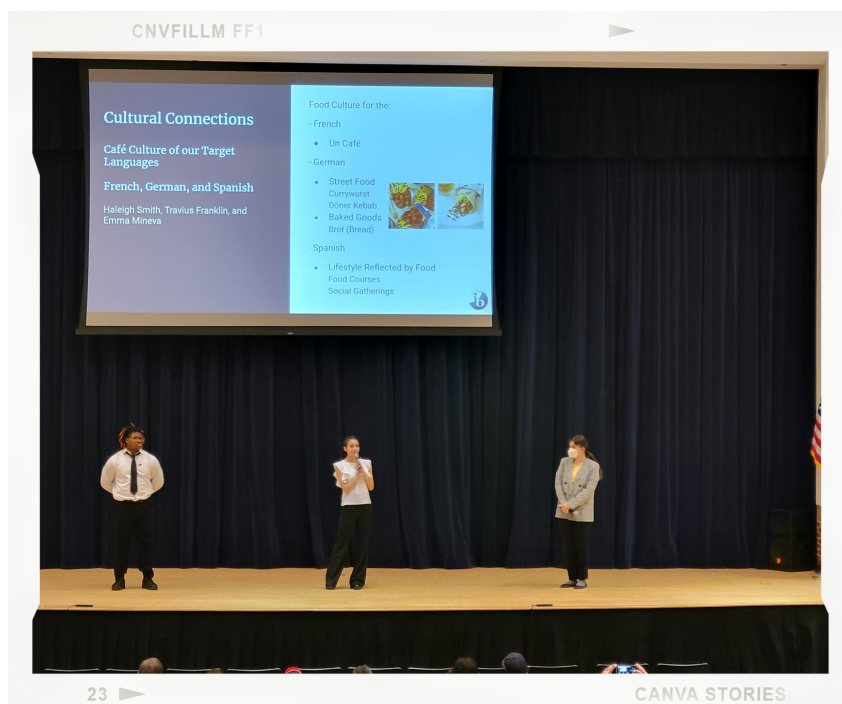

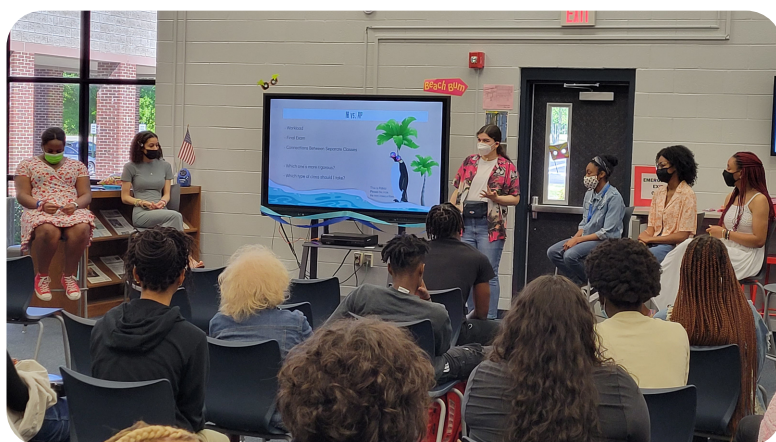


IB Symposium
