Senior's Final Transcript Orders:

Paper copies of Final Transcripts may be ordered through MySchoolBucks. (Select "FINAL Transcript" under the drop-down option when ordering \$5.) Graduates will need to mail the paper final transcript to the college they will be attending along with official transcripts from dual enrollment schools if applicable. (DE transcripts are requested directly from the DE institution. A link should be available on their website). Summer School 2022

Summer School 2022 will be held in person at LIFE Academy located at 450 Grady Ave, Fayetteville, or virtually. Students are required to actively participate 5 days per week during the summer school session, June 6 - June 30, 2022, or they will be dropped from the program. Registration is currently open and will close on June 1 at 4:00 pm. Students or parents need to email their school counselor to register. In-person or Virtual options - All classes will be on Edgenuity. Students may register for up to 4 courses. (Math, science, social studies, and English core courses only). Transportation will be provided to In-Person students who request it - Tell your school counselor when you sign up. After registration parents and students (FCBOE e-mail accounts) are expected to check their email daily.

Classes are on a "Credit Repair" model - Students cannot take "New Credit" classes. Previously -failed classes must have a final average of at least 50 or "Z" score. Upon successful completion of Summer School classes, students will earn a "70" as a final grade.

ATTIRE FOR GRADUATES

<u>Females</u>: Lightweight dress, skirt or slacks (no jeans) and blouse. No heels please due to the turf field. *<u>Males</u>*: White shirt, dark tie, dark dress pants (no jeans) and dark dress shoes.

PICTURES

Parents and guests will not be permitted on the track or field during graduation to take pictures and/or to observe the ceremony. A professional photographer will take pictures of each graduate receiving his/her diploma. Information about purchasing this photograph will be mailed to you.

SEATING

Sandy Creek High School will provide on a first come, first serve basis. There will be no tickets given out but we do suggest early arrival. Stadium gates open to the public at 5:30 pm.

HANDICAPPED SEATING

Sandy Creek High School will provide special seating for the elderly and handicapped on a first come, first serve basis. We can only accommodate one family member to accompany an individual utilizing this special seating area.

RESTROOMS

The main building will be closed to parents and guests prior to and during the graduation ceremony. Restrooms are available next to the concession stands in the stadium.

DIPLOMA PICK-UP

Diploma covers will be issued at the graduation ceremony. Students will report to the gym immediately following the ceremony to pick up their actual diploma and other paperwork. Graduates must have cleared all obligations to receive their diplomas.

View Student Transcripts

Students can see an unofficial copy of their transcript without requesting/paying for a copy!

- 1. Students can log on to their IC account
- 2. Click on the menu symbol in the upper left corner (3 lines)
- 3. Click on "Documents".
- 4. Click on "Portal Transcript"

This copy will not show your GPA but will show you the classes you have taken since entering high school, the final grade you earned, and if you earned your credit for the class.

This can empower students and parents/guardians to know if and what students need to take in a credit recovery class or in summer school so that students can take the required action and graduate on time.
