EOC MILESTONES ARE UPON US: (EOC Testing Schedule)

April 19th - American Literature (Section 1) and Algebra I (Section 1)
April 20th - American Literature (Section 2 & 3) and Algebra I (Section 2)
April 21st - US History and Biology (Section 1 and 2)

Brick and Mortar students received their specific testing locations. Virtual students will report to the auditorium lobby each morning prior to 8:15am to receive their testing locations. In addition, it is important that students follow the testing procedures below.:

1. Bring your fully charged chromebook, in the case, for testing.

2. Leave cell phones, personal digital assistants (PDAs), Blackberrys, smartphones, Bluetooth-enabled devices, MP3 players, email/messaging devices, portable listening devices, pagers, beepers, PSPs, photographic devices, cameras, or any other electronic or communication devices at home. If you are found with any of these devices, your test will be invalidated and your scores cancelled. You will not have access to any of these devices during the time you are in the testing room.

3. A calculator will be provided; no other calculators will be allowed (Algebra I ONLY). An online calculator will also be provided in the testing platform.

4. No one will be able to enter the test late or leave early. Please arrive on-time.

5. DO NOT BRING THE FOLLOWING ITEMS INTO THE TESTING SITE: Backpacks, bags, books, compasses, mechanical pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, notes, colored pencils, scratch paper (this will be provided for you), reference guides, keyboard maps or other typing instructions, clothing with subject-related information.

All virtual students will test at their home school. Virtual students will not test at the school their teacher is assigned. Please plan accordingly.
