### Student parking update:

Parents and students, we have added a few speed bumps to our student parking lot to help slow things down a little. We are currently working on a ONE WAY plan that will allow 2 lanes of entry and exit, eliminate the cross traffic at the gym entry and hopefully speed up the process for parents and students to drop off or park. Additionally, we hope to install crosswalks for students to safely cross from the parking lot to the side walk. \*\*If you have not purchased your parking permit please do so as soon as possible to avoid earning a financial obligation.SCHS currently charges the lowest price set by FCBOE. There have been no changes to the security cost and county fees for parking therefore there has not been a change in the cost of the permit, per county policy. 2020-2021 Student Parking permits at SCHS are \$50. # <u>Clinic</u>

#### PROTOCOL FOR REPORTING CASES OF COVID:

As with any communicable disease, the school requests that parents report to the school nurse any confirmed cases of COVID-19 within our student body so that appropriate contact tracing can be performed. FCBOE nurses have been trained by theDepartment of Public Health to complete contact tracing. If a student is exposed to a confirmed case of COVID-19 (exposure is defined as 15 minutes or more closer than 6 feet away with no personal protective equipment OR in contact with bodily excretions OR living with someone who is positive), the student should self-isolate for 14 days. If the student develops symptoms or if the student is diagnosed with a positive case, 10 days of self-isolation from the onset of symptoms or the positive test are also necessary. The student may return to school after the 14 days of quarantine (if asymptomatic) or after the 10 days of isolation (following the onset of symptoms or a positive test) provided that the student is symptom free without medications for 24 hours before the student may return. If we discover that a student has been potentially exposed at school (meeting the definition above), parents/guardians will be notified. The county has seen asymptomatic people who get tested, do not tell anyone that they got tested, and return to school. Four or five days later, they receive a positive test result. At that point, we have to start contact tracing and quarantining those who are identified as having been exposed to the person tested. Had they remained at home after the test, most likely no additional persons would have been quarantined. When a person gets tested, they need to self-quarantine immediately until they get their test results.
