## DIPLOMA PICK-UP

Diploma covers will be issued at the graduation ceremony. Students will recess to the auditorium immediately following the ceremony to pick up their actual diploma and other paperwork. Graduates must have cleared all obligations to receive their diplomas.



## TRANSCRIPTS

Final transcripts should be ordered through the Counselor's office no later than May 20th. The cost for each transcript is \$3.00. Go to the front desk in the Guidance office to order transcripts. Final transcripts will be placed in the graduation folders to be picked up after graduation. Graduates are responsible for sending their own transcript to their post-grad option.
