Robert J. Burch Elementary Goals

Reading - Increase by 2% annually, the percentage of 3rd - 5th students and subgroups reading on grade level or above as measured by GMAS End of Grade reading indicator.

ELA & Math - Increase by 3% annually the percentage of students and subgroups scoring at Proficient and Distinguished Achievement Levels as measured by GMAS End of Grade Assessment.

During the 2024-2025 school year 50% of students will have a 50% or higher growth percentile as measured by STAR assessments.

<u>School Climate</u> - Improve student leadership opportunities, attendance, and positive behavior; and increase staff and family engagement as measured by state, district, and school surveys.
