Sandy Creek High School is pleased to announce the addition of our STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) Academy. This rigorous and innovative academic program will provide our students with experiences and skills that will prepare them for competitive college programs and a career in STEM. Currently, 20% of all U.S. jobs are STEM-related and those numbers are expected to increase, not only in the United States, but globally. Our STEM program will use advanced technologies and real-world applications to excite and engage students to become critical-thinkers, solution-oriented and sustainability-conscious young professionals.

The benefit of being a part of our STEM Academy will be the preparation for rigorous college work, through our AP courses, additional science and CTE courses our students will be well rounded and prepared for a research university. Research universities like Georgia Tech, UGA and other top out of state institutions they are looking for the best students not just the best GPA. Top universities want to see students taking AP courses, completing pathways and challenging themselves. The STEM Academy will consist of three programs: Advanced Life Science, Engineering, and Computer Science. STEM student requirements are:

- Maintaining 3.0 or higher GPA
- Enrolled in Accelerated Math all 4 years of High School
- Research projects each semester
- Participation in Academic Team

- Participation in Honors Society when eligible (10th & 11th grade)
- Participation of STEM Academy club meetings, service project and STEM talks
- Take required courses as indicated on sample schedule
