How to apply: The applicant must submit all application materials by the deadline date. The completed packet may be turned in to the counselors' office in the designated area for PTSO, or it can be printed and scanned to the PTSO email, sandycreekhsptso@gmail.com. Make sure *Attention: PTSO Scholarship Committee* is listed on the subject line of the email.

Cover sheet: A SCHS English Language Arts teacher is required to review the essay and initial the cover sheet. You may choose any SCHS ELA teacher. If you are a virtual student and would like to use your virtual teacher, that is fine. Get your counselor to write in the unweighted GPA and initial on the line next to it. If

the GPA is below 2.8, you are not eligible for this scholarship. You will be assigned an entry number upon submission of your completed scholarship packet.

Application: Fill out the application completely. On line 5 do not use your school email. If we need to contact you, we need a personal email address. If you answer "No" to questions 6 and/or 8, you are **not** eligible to apply for this scholarship, and your packet will not be considered. To answer "yes" to line 6, your parent or guardian must be a paid PTSO member as of the date you submit the packet but not later than February 28, 2021. Please make sure to list the parent or guardian that is a member of the PTSO on line 7. This name will be used to verify membership. Please attach proof of your acceptance into an institution of higher learning to the application.

Essay: Please utilize the essay rubric included as you write the essay. The essay should be typed, at least 500-words, double-spaced, Times New Roman font size 12. Write on the following topic:

As a senior who is about to graduate from Sandy Creek High School, write an essay directed to the administration and faculty explaining what has been good about your experience at SCHS and what could have been better while attending school during COVID-19. Then, consider and explain your answer with specific, realistic changes that could have made this school year better (i.e. improve student morale, school pride, the overall high school experience, etc.) during this pandemic.

Extracurricular/Community Service/ Employment Activities: Please fill out all activities for each year of high school. If there is formal record keeping, please attach a copy to verify. SCHS Club and activity sponsors can initial next to activities that you list if there is no formal record keeping. The same applies for outside organizations. For employment activities, list the company name, job title, and dates of employment.

Scholarship winner: The PTSO scholarship review team will evaluate and select the winner based on the essay, GPA, extracurricular activities, community service, and employment activities.

- ★ Parent/Guardian must be a member of the PTSO as of the date of submission or no later than **February 28, 2021.**
