

# School Parent and Family Engagement Policy

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In support of strengthening student academic achievement, Flat Rock Middle School receives Title I, Part A funds and therefore must jointly develop with, agree on with, and distribute to parents and family members of participating children a written parent and family engagement policy that contains information required by section 1116(b) and (c) of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). - → Be governed by the following statutory definition of parent and family engagement and will carry out programs, activities, and procedures in accordance with this definition:
  - ◆ Parent and Family Engagement means the participation of parents in regular, two-way, and meaningful communication involving student academic learning and other school activities, including ensuring:
  - (A) Parents play an integral role in assisting their child's learning
  - (B) Parents are encouraged to be actively involved in their child's education at school
  - (C) Parents are full partners in their child's education and are included, as appropriate, in decision-making and on advisory committees to assist in the education of their child
  - (D) Other activities are carried out, such as those described in Section 1116 of the ESSA





#### JOINTLY DEVELOPED

## ANNUAL TITLE I MEETING

#### BUILDING CAPACITY OF SCHOOL STAFF
