As a school-wide Title I program, we are required by federal law, the Elementary and Secondary Education Assistance Act of 1965 (ESEA) to let you know about your child's teachers' and/or paraprofessional's qualifications. It is your right to request the following information regarding his/her credentials:


- Whether the teacher met the state requirements from the Georgia Professional Standards Commission for certification for the grade level and subject area which they teach;
- Whether the teacher is teaching under an emergency or temporary status through which Georgia qualifications or certification criteria have been waived;
- What undergraduate or graduate degree(s) the teacher holds, including graduate certificates and additional degrees, and major(s) or area(s) of concentration; and
- Whether your child is provided services by paraprofessionals, and if so, his/her qualifications.

Please know that our staff is committed to helping your child reach his/her highest academic potential throughout his/her school career. That commitment includes making sure that all of your teachers and paraprofessionals are highly skilled and are providing quality instruction to your child.
