### ATTIRE

<b>Graduation Practice</b>	Cool, comfortable, appropriate attire. School <b>dress code</b> will be enforced. Shoulders and midriffs must be covered and shorts must be fingertip length. *(Face covering required when indoors.)	
<b>Graduation</b>	<p><u>Females</u> *Lightweight dress, skirt or dark slacks (no jeans) and blouse. Face covering is required at all times. *<b>No heels allowed. Wedges or flats only.</b> <a href="#">Click for examples.</a></p>	<p><u>Males</u> White shirt, dark tie, dark dress pants (no jeans) and dark dress shoes. Face covering is required at all times.</p>

### TURF FIELD

For the maintenance and preservation of our turf field, please adhere to the following guidelines:

- No food, drinks, or gum is allowed on the turf field.
- No heels are allowed on the field.
- No animals, other than registered service animals, are allowed on the field.

### PARKING

### PICTURES

Parents and guests will not be permitted on the track or field during graduation to take pictures and/or to observe the ceremony. A professional photographer will take pictures of each graduate receiving his/her diploma. Information about purchasing this photograph will be mailed to you. **\*No pictures will be allowed on the field\***

### **HANDICAPPED SEATING**

Fayette County High School will provide special seating for the elderly and handicapped on a first come, first serve basis. We can only accommodate one family member to accompany an individual utilizing this special seating.

### **RESTROOMS**

The main building will be closed to parents and guests prior to and during the graduation ceremony. Restrooms are available next to the concession stand in the stadium.

### **DIPLOMA PICK-UP**

Diploma covers will be issued at the graduation ceremony. Students will report to the auditorium immediately following the ceremony to pick up their actual diploma and other paperwork. Graduates must have cleared all obligations to receive their diplomas.

### **TRANSCRIPTS**

Final transcripts should be ordered through the Counselor's office no later than May 21st. The cost for each transcript is \$3.00. Go to the front desk in the Guidance office to order transcripts. Final transcripts will be placed in the graduation folders to be picked up after graduation.
