

Fayette County High School SENIOR GRADUATION INFORMATION Class of 2018



- Graduation activities are tentative and are dependent on seniors not abusing attendance laws, regulations of the Board of Education, or school standards of good judgment and behavior.
- During the senior luncheon and drum-out, seniors must be in all assigned areas when on campus and not
 wandering in the halls or classrooms. All school rules and directions must be followed. Any senior violating
 them will be disciplined. Please remember to bring all your belongings with you to the senior luncheon. You
 will not be allowed back in the building after drum out.
- Seniors will not be excused from practices for work. All seniors (including early graduates, dual enrollment, and work program seniors) who plan to participate in Baccalaureate or Graduation exercises are required to participate in the practice for that ceremony. Appropriate dress is required at these practices. No parking will be allowed on the Lafayette Education Center campus.
- All seniors must clear fines and obligations <u>before</u> they will be allowed to participate in Graduation practices!
- At Baccalaureate/Graduation Gentlemen are <u>required</u> to wear black or dark trousers, black or dark shoes, white dress shirts, and a neutral or dark colored tie under gowns. Coats are not necessary and will only be in the way.
- At Baccalaureate/Graduation Ladies are <u>required</u> to wear black or dark dresses and black or dark dress shoes. A low heel (non- pointy) or flat shoe is required. Boots, tennis shoes and flip-flops <u>are not</u> acceptable.
- At Graduation Ladies, Gentlemen and All Guests are asked to wear a low flat heel (non- pointy) or flat shoe
 ONLY. No other type of heel can be worn on the football field because it will damage the field. High heels are acceptable at Baccalaureate.
- Any student who fails to dress as indicated, who appears to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol, or
 exhibits inappropriate behavior will be pulled from the Baccalaureate and/or Graduation exercises and will
 not be allowed to participate.
- Gates will open for Graduation at 5:30pm. Prior to that time, no one will be allowed entry. Seating is on a first come basis. No lawn chairs or coolers are permitted. Handicap parking will be available in the upper parking lot, FCHS permit required or Handicap permit required. Handicap seating is available at the top of the stadium on the home side. Handicap seating is also available on the front rows of the visitor side. There is limited handicap parking on the visitor side due to construction.
- All final transcript requests must be turned in to the Guidance Office on or before May 4, 2018. The cost is \$3.00. Any request made after May 4th will cost \$5.00.

We will attempt to follow the dates and times on the calendar; however, they are subject to change. In the case of changes, you will be notified.

FINAL EXAM INFORMATION

Graduating seniors may qualify for exam exemptions in the following manner:

A. May exempt any/all classes with an average of 80 or higher **AND** with no more than 5 check-in/out and/or absences (transactions) as determined by the attendance office. THINK: Attendance Policy Exemptions

or

B. May exempt a maximum of 3 exams with grades of 95 or more. THINK: Academic Policy Exemptions

A student may choose "A" or "B" but not both! Non-graduating seniors will follow the regular exemption rules.
