



Lunchtime Role Models

- Students are taught the PBIS lunchroom expectations by their homeroom teachers and re-taught as needed.
- Each day, café monitors will watch for the classes that best model these three categories: Most Ready, Most Respectful, and Most Responsible.
 - A winner is selected for each grade level. (PK will be in the kindergarten category)
 - A different class may be chosen for each category or the same class may be chosen for more than one category.
 - In the event that no class appropriately models the PBIS lunchroom expectations, no winner will be named for that category on that day.
 - Classes may tie! If more than one class models exceptional behavior in a category, then more than one class wins for the day!
 - Daily role model winners are recognized with Points on the PBIS Lunchroom Class Dojo chart.
- **REWARD: Role Model Friday Luncheon in the Commons!!!**
 - Homeroom Role Model Competition cycles last for two weeks.
 - At the end of the cycle, the classes with the most Dojo Points for each grade level will enjoy their lunch in the Commons with a, drum roll, please...special MOVIE!!!
(Note: Homeroom teachers will NOT need to monitor.)
 - Role Model Friday Luncheons will take place the last Friday of the cycle. Winning homerooms will be announced on broadcast
 - Due to volume, Role Model Fridays will rotate.
 - K, 2nd, and 4th will celebrate on the same Friday, while 1st, 3rd, and 5th will celebrate on the alternate Friday.
 - The Role Model Competition will reset the day after the Role Model Luncheon. The sticker board will be cleared and all classes start fresh.
