



FRMS Clubs 2021-22


Food Forest Club



6th,7th, and 8th Graders this club meets on the 1st and 3rd Friday of each month.



This club is for anyone who likes to learn about different cultures. Get hands on cultural experience in the International Club!




Science Olympiad


This club is for 6th, 7th, and 8th graders and meets on the 2nd and 4th Friday of the month.

This club is only for 7th and 8th Graders and meets on the 1st Friday of each month.


Students in this club will serve as Student Ambassadors, and give new students tours of the school. Additionally, they will attend special topic meetings with guest speakers.



Broadcasting Club


6th, 7th, and 8th Graders this club meets on all four Fridays of the month.

Academic Bowl is limited to 15 participants and requires a "tryout" test and fee to join.


The \$20 required fee includes t-shirt and registration fee.

Photo Club


6th, 7th, & 8th Graders this club meets after school only
