STEP 2: Complete Online Application

Students must complete one online application for each course in which he/she wants to apply. This applies to courses listed in the recommendation/potential letter as well. The application is on the SMHS website (Student Resources → Advanced Placement). Students wanting to take more than the following number of AP courses must get administrative approval:

9th Grade~ 1 course 10th Grade~ 2 courses 11th Grade~ 3 courses 12th Grade~ 3 courses

STEP 3: Determine Requirements for Each Course

1) Recommendation/Potential Letter received via school email

There are no additional requirements for courses listed in a recommendation/potential letter. Students identified by College Board as having potential in certain courses received letters in their school email on December 18, 2019. Students do not have to apply for all courses listed in the letter. In addition, students are encouraged to apply for courses in which he/she did not have listed in the letter.

2) Standard Qualification

Students who did not receive a recommendation/potential letter or students wanting to applying for an AP class not listed on the letter must fulfill the specific requirements listed. **IF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS ARE NOT FULFILLED, THE APPLICATION WILL BE CONSIDERED INCOMPLETE.**
