What Is Title I?

MISSION: The mission of Title I is to provide supplemental services and resources to assist students in achieving local learning goals and targets.

Since 1965 and the passage of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act and the newly adopted Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), Title I provides a source of federal funding to America's schools. Based on local FR% data and demographics, Title I schools are able to provide supplemental instructional services and resources to assist students in achieving local learning goals and targets.

NFES is a school-wide Title 1 School, allowed under the 2001 No Child Left Behind Act. Schools are eligible to implement supplemental instructional services as targeted programs. Ensuring all students in the school, primarily those who are at-risk, satisfy expected achievement levels on local and state measures, remain the goal of school-wide programming.

Title I requires schools complete a Comprehensive Needs Assessment(CNA), design specific goals and interventions to respond to the needs, develop a comprehensive plan (SIP-SWP) and conduct an annual review of the program.

Title I is about designing an effective program with a "GROWTH" mindset. <u>Continuous Reflection</u>: How does our Title I Program support student achievement growth and success?



Parents right to know

In compliance with the requirements of the Every Student Succeeds Act, parents may request the following information:

Whether the student's teacher:

 has met State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction; is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived; and is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher.

Whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.

All of our teachers and paraprofessionals are certified by the Georgia Professional Standards Commission and each day our staff works to engage, challenge and support all students to achieve at high levels.
