## Fayette County Career Fair 2017

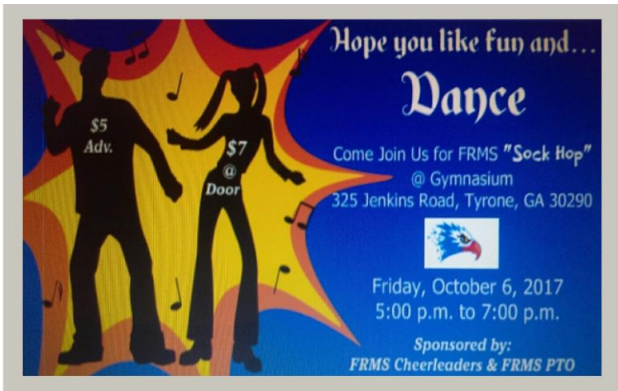
