

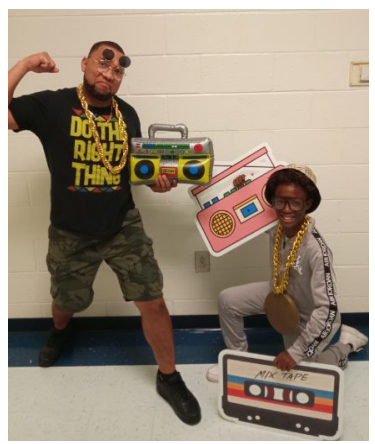

BETA Club

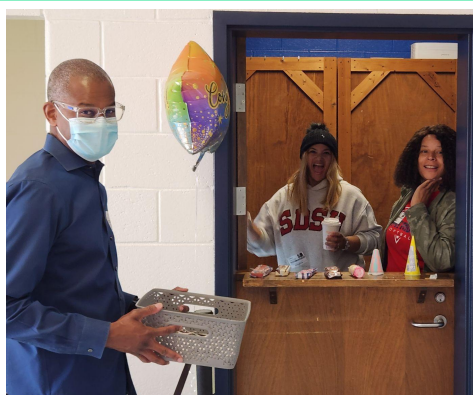
