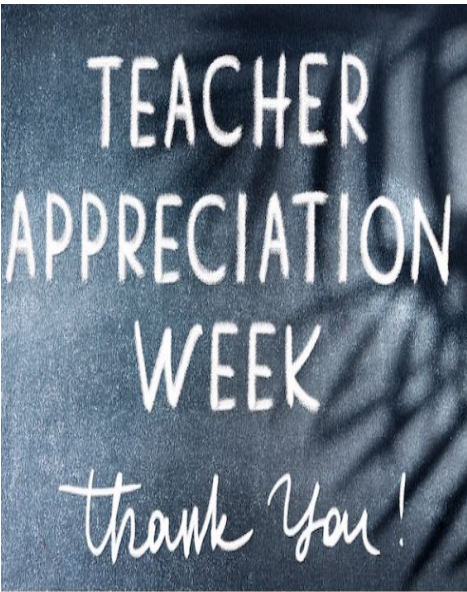

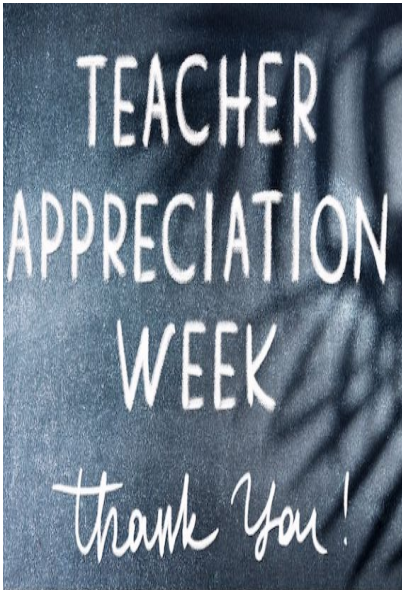

INFORMACIÓN SOBRE LOS GEORGIA MILESTONES

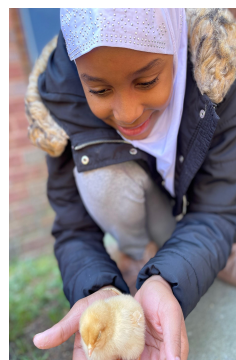
