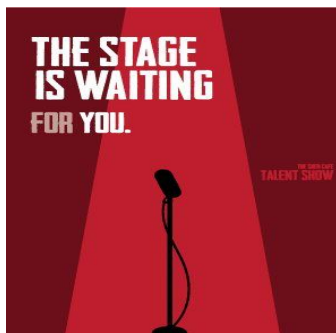
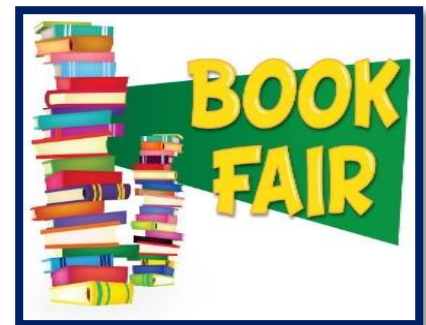


## INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE PROGRAM

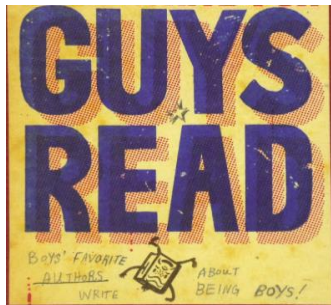

We will be meeting soon to discuss books that we have selected to read together.

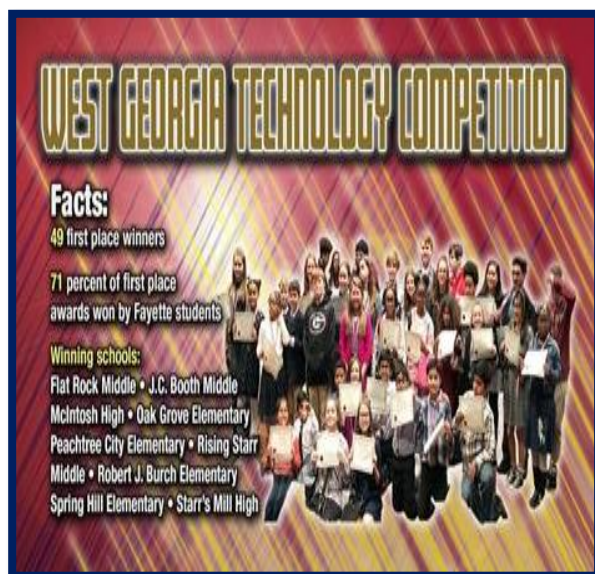
