Only ID and proof of residence are required at pre-registration.

Monday-Friday, Sept 10-14 and Monday-Friday, Sept 17-21

9am - noon; 1pm - 4pm (until spots are full)

No children allowed during registration

* Previous Angel Tree clients can only register if they completed a Life Skills course in 2018.

Each family seeking assistance <u>must</u> apply in person in their county of residence and <u>must</u> bring the following items to register:

- * Valid photo I.D.
- * Social Security Card or proof of Tax I.D. Number
 - Consulate Cards (i.e., Matricula) may be used in lieu of Social Security Cards.
- * Proof of Residence: Must bring <u>current lease</u> OR <u>current utility bill</u> OR <u>mail</u> received from the government OR School District in August or September.
- * Proof of Need: Must bring <u>ONE</u> of the following in the applicant's name.
 - Section 8 or HUD lease documents
 - Medicaid, Peachcare, or SNAP eligibility letter
 - If you do not receive the above government assistance, please bring proof of your monthly expenses and all income sources.
- * Birth Certificates and Social Security Cards for all children being registered.
 - *Consulate Cards (i.e., Matricula) may be used in lieu of Social Security Cards.
- * Official custody or guardianship papers if applicant is not the biological parent.
- * Clothing and shoe sizes for each child.
