Guest Speaker, Mr. Charles Walls (also known as DJ Perfect) came out and explained the Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Mathematics used in being a disc jockey. Mr. Walls is an Instructional Technology Educator as well as a DJ for events such as weddings, school dances, birthdays, etc. On May 3rd, in celebration of GA STEM day Mr. Walls came out to Flat Rock and showed the students how to use the Stem file format to create a program playlist of songs (over 3,000) and how to use the mathematics component to ensure the beats per second were programmed correctly. The students had a chance to demonstrate their abilities while learning at the same time.. We are humbled and grateful for such a wonderful learning opportunity.

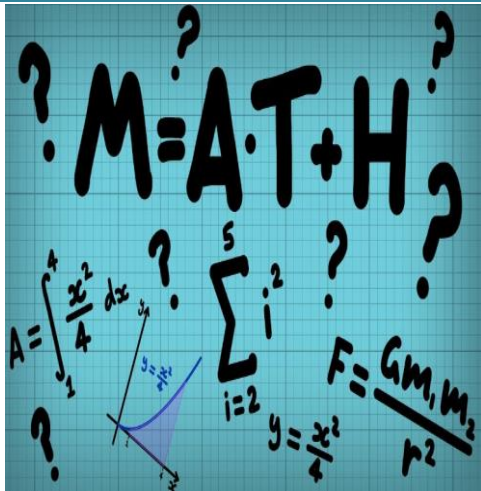
ENDURANCE: The ability to withstand something challenging or difficult.
