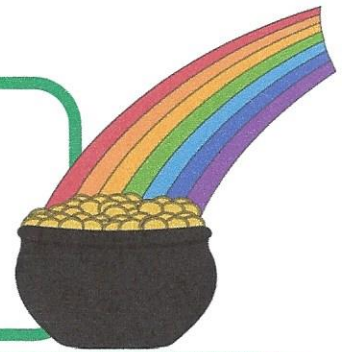

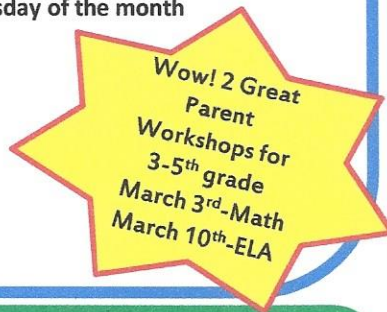

7 Ways to Make Your Own Luck

1. It all begins with attitude.

6. Believe in yourself.

To make your own luck you need to believe that you can. Confidence. It's the key to being able to handle whatever comes your way. Believe that you can handle it. Believe that you can find solutions, get support, & figure it out.

7. Be generous and giving.
