IMPORTANT NEWS AND REMINDERS

- **Class of 2023:** Senior portrait dates are April 30, May 7, and May 14. Students will receive information directly from BPI. This information will also be posted on our WHS [website](#).

- **Rising 10th-12th graders:** Kennesaw State University is offering a free, virtual, summer workshop on Holocaust Studies in June. Application closes May 27, 2022. Visit [this](#) website to apply and for more information.

- **Dual enrollment for 2022-2023 school year:** Dual enrollment is a state funded program that allows students to earn both high school and college credit for certain classes. Any student interested in participating in dual enrollment next school year must follow and complete the steps by May 1, 2022. Students currently participating in dual enrollment must also attend/watch an informational meeting, complete the dual enrollment contract, meet with his/her counselor to approve classes, and register for classes at the college by May 1, 2022. Both the student and a parent/guardian must either attend an in person meeting or watch the meeting presentation online (available in the student's schoology account). The recommendation is that all students who will be new to dual enrollment during the 22-23 school year attend an in person meeting (college reps are available to speak with at the in person DE meetings). Attending an in person meeting or watching the presentation online and completing the contract must be completed by **March 30, 2022**. The presentation and document will no longer be available after this date.
