#### **IMPORTANT NEWS AND REMINDERS**

- → Seniors: Mid-year reports, including updated transcripts will be released to colleges/universities at the end of January. Make sure that the colleges/universities you have applied to are in Naviance so the schools will receive your updated transcript. The FAFSA (financial aid application) will open on December 31st. We will host a FAFSA Night for parents on January 9th at 6:00 pm in the Media Center. A GSFC representative will be here to help guide you through the new FAFSA process.
- → Scholarship Spotlight: Coweta-Fayette EMC is offering scholarships to students who want to attend either trade school or attend a 4 year college.
