IMPORTANT NEWS AND REMINDERS

- ► FINAL EXAMS (New Process!): This year exemptions will be done online. Students will still notify their teachers on December 7, but parents will have to sign off on exemptions via their Infinite Campus parent portal through a survey. Make sure that your contact information is up to date in Infinite Campus. Exemption forms will be available through email at 11:00 AM on December 9 and will close at 4:00 PM on December 11. Make sure you look for the survey; this will allow your child to exempt and/or leave at the end of the exam period.
- ▶ **Sophomores:** Your school counselor will be meeting with you to discuss your career goals and what you can do in high school to support these goals. This would include identifying classes to take; clubs/organizations to participate in; and programs to participate in (Advanced Placement, Dual Enrollment, Work Based Learning).
- → 9th-12th: Prepare for final exams. Attend review sessions offered by teachers and study previous quizzes/tests. This <u>article</u> provides 20 Study Strategies for Finals Week (and before!)
- → 11th-12th: The ASVAB is available free of charge for 11th and 12th graders and will be administered in the WHS Auditorium on Friday, January 22nd during periods 1-3. The ASVAB Career Exploration Program is a comprehensive career exploration and planning program that includes a multiple aptitude test battery, an interest inventory, and various career planning tools designed to help students explore the world of work. Click here to sign up. Your student must be logged into their student Gmail account to register. Testing capacity will be limited and all CDC and local guidelines for schools will be in place.
