IMPORTANT NEWS AND REMINDERS

- → All students: start off the semester strong. All teachers offer help sessions before/after school, if you are struggling in class get help early. Speak to your teacher about when he/she is available and when you will be coming in for extra help. Additionally, stop by the Counseling office if you would like a science department and/or math department help session calendar.
- → All students: Need a tutor? GA Tutor is a free online tutoring service offered by Georgia Virtual. To sign up for a virtual tutoring session log in to Infinite Campus and then go to the SLDS portal. Click on GA Tutor to sign up for a specific tutoring session. You will join the session on Zoom at the assigned time. Click here for subjects offered and for more information.
- → Dual enrollment for 2024-2025 school year: Dual enrollment is a state funded program that allows students to earn both high school and college credit for certain classes. Any student interested in participating in dual enrollment next school year must follow and complete the steps by May 1, 2024. Students are responsible for checking the admissions requirements at each participating institution. Students currently participating in dual enrollment must also attend/watch an informational meeting, complete the dual enrollment contract, meet with his/her counselor to approve classes, and register for classes at the college by May 1, 2024. Both the student and a parent/guardian must either attend an in person meeting or watch the meeting presentation online (available in the student's schoology account). The recommendation is that all students who will be new to dual enrollment during the 24-25 school year attend an in person meeting. All meetings will be held at the Center of Innovation (COI) 250 Peachtree Parkway Peachtree City. The next information sessions will be held on the following dates:
