IMPORTANT NEWS AND REMINDERS

- Sophomores: Your school counselor will be meeting with you to discuss your career goals and what you can do in high school to support these goals. This would include identifying classes to take; clubs/organizations to participate in; and programs to participate in (Advanced Placement, Dual Enrollment, Work Based Learning).
- ➡ 9th-12th: Strategies and habits that lead to academic success:
 - 1. Set aside focused time to work on homework assignments. This means away from your phone and other distractions.
 - 2. Ask your teacher about help sessions before school and attend them.
 - 3. Hand write notes and complete reading assignments.
 - 4. Work with peers to study for tests/quizzes.
 - 5. Sleep and eat a healthy diet. Your brain needs both in order to function optimally.
