### IMPORTANT NEWS AND REMINDERS

- **Seniors:** Your School Counselor will meet individually with you between late August-October to discuss the path to graduation, post-secondary plans, and how to use Naviance to send required application materials to colleges/universities. If a recommendation letter is needed for a college application and/or scholarship, students are required to complete the Brag Sheet located on Schoology and share it with his/her counselor. As a courtesy, students should ask teachers and counselors for recommendation letters at least 3 weeks prior to the application deadline.
  
- **Seniors,** College Application Team (CAT) will be held after school in the Counseling Office from 3:45-4:30 on Wednesdays September 7th-October 26th. This is the perfect opportunity to get one on one help with college applications.
  
- **Sophomores:** Will complete the YouScience Career Aptitude Inventory during the week of October 10th. This instrument gives students excellent career information based on their individual aptitudes. School counselors will be in your World History class on Wednesday October 12th to give you information about access to your individual report and the assignment to be completed.
  
- **Juniors:** School counselors will be visiting your English class on Friday October 21st to discuss ACT/SAT and preparing for college admissions. The presentation will be posted to the WHS [website](#) following completion of the class visits.
