IMPORTANT NEWS AND REMINDERS

- → All students: start off the semester strong. All teachers offer help sessions before/after school, if you are struggling in class get help early. Speak to your teacher about when he/she is available and when you will be coming in for extra help. Additionally, stop by the Counseling office if you would like a science department and/or math department help session calendar.
- → Dual enrollment for 2023-2024 school year: Dual enrollment is a state funded program that allows students to earn both high school and college credit for certain classes. Any student interested in participating in dual enrollment next school year must follow and complete the steps by May 1, 2023. Students should register now for an ACT/SAT, if the test is required for admission to your dual enrollment institution. Students are responsible for checking the admissions requirements at each participating institution. Students currently participating in dual enrollment must also attend/watch an informational meeting, complete the dual enrollment contract, meet with his/her counselor to approve classes, and register for classes at the college by May 1, 2023. Both the student and a parent/guardian must either attend an in person meeting or watch the meeting presentation online (available in the student's schoology account). The recommendation is that all students who will be new to dual enrollment during the 23-24 school year attend an in person meeting. All meetings will be held at the Center of Innovation (COI) 250 Peachtree Parkway Peachtree City.
