IMPORTANT NEWS AND REMINDERS

→ Dual enrollment for 2024-2025 school year: Dual enrollment is a state funded program that allows students to earn both high school and college credit for certain classes. Any student interested in participating in dual enrollment next school year must follow and complete the steps by May 1, 2024. Students should register now for an ACT/SAT, if the test is required for admission to your dual enrollment institution. Students are responsible for checking the admissions requirements at each participating institution. Students currently participating in dual enrollment must also attend/watch an informational meeting, complete the dual enrollment contract, meet with his/her counselor to approve classes, and register for classes at the college by May 1, 2024. Both the student and a parent/guardian must either attend an in person meeting or watch the meeting presentation online (available in the student's schoology account). The recommendation is that all students who will be new to dual enrollment during the 24-25 school year attend an in person meeting. All meetings will be held at the Center of Innovation (COI) 250 Peachtree Parkway Peachtree City. An interested student must watch or attend an informational meeting by March 31, 2024 for SY 24-25 eligibility. Tuesday March 26, 2024 @ 6:30pm-last in-person meeting for dual enrollment

- → Counselors are meeting with current **9th graders** during the week of March 11th. We meet with students individually each year for registration in order to advise students in course selection based on their career and academic goals. Counselors are working diligently to have meetings with students who were absent or we were not able to meet with earlier. These meetings will be complete by the end of March.
- → All Students: Camp MAGIK, a healing camp for bereaved children and adolescents, is announcing its Spring 2024 camp session. This session will be held at The Calvin Center in Hampton, GA, April 21-23, 2024. Applications need to be postmarked or emailed to us no later than April 8, 2024. Camp Horizon is another healing camp and registration is open for 2024. This free camp is open to any child ages 6-16 who has lost a loved one. This year's camp is Saturday, June 22nd at Community Bible Church in Stockbridge. Click here to register. Both camps are free!
