IMPORTANT NEWS AND REMINDERS

- → Dual enrollment for 2024-2025 school year: If students attended/watched the meeting/video and completed the contract by March 29, 2024, then the next step is for the student to apply to his/her college of choice. Be sure to upload your acceptance letter to the dual enrollment Schoology page. Next, students should initiate contact with his/her counselor to share that he/she has been accepted to a dual enrollment institution and ready for the next step of course selection/approval. For questions regarding transferability of credit you can look at GA Transfer linked here or call the admissions office of the 4 year college/university. Students must be registered for dual enrollment classes by May 1, 2024.
- → Summer School Credit Recovery 2024: If you need to take classes this summer in order to be on track for graduation, think about participating in the Fayette County Schools High School Credit Recovery Program. Classes will be held at Fayette Life Academy The cost is \$200 per .5 credit and will run from June 5th-June 27th. You must register in person at Fayette Life Academy on June 3rd from 8:00 until 12:00. More information can be found https://example.com/here.
- → Class of 2025: It's time to schedule your senior portrait appointment with BPI! Photographers will be at WHS on May 18th, June 1st, and June 15th to take senior pictures. You can also go to the BPI studios, which are north of Atlanta. Portraits from other photographers cannot be used in the yearbook. All portraits must be made by August 9th. - → 11th graders: The Georgia Ready Summer Institute will be held July 9-14, 2024 and is for highly motivated and underrepresented students who want to experience what it's like to be a college student at UGA.
