### IMPORTANT NEWS AND REMINDERS

- **Seniors:** Your School Counselor will meet individually with you between August-October to discuss the path to graduation, post-secondary plans, and how to use Naviance to send required application materials to colleges/universities. If a recommendation letter is needed for a college application and/or scholarship, students are required to complete the Brag Sheet located on Schoology and share it with his/her counselor. As a courtesy, students should ask teachers and counselors for recommendation letters at least 3 weeks prior to the application deadline.
- **Seniors,** College Application Time (CAT) will be held after school in the Counseling Suite from 3:45-4:30 on Tuesdays (Group A) and Thursdays (Group B) during the month of September. This is the perfect opportunity to get one on one help with college applications.

- **Counseling Group:** The first counseling group offered this year will be a general student support group that focuses on overall mental and physical health, coping skills, conflict resolution, problem solving skills.
