

Braelinn Club Information 2019-20

Braelinn faculty members volunteer their time, before or after school, to provide clubs for students to meet a wide variety of interests. Sign-up forms will come home separately for each club and will correspond with the appropriate time of year that the club is being offered. Many clubs have limited seating and will be filled on a first-come, first served basis with wait lists created using the same process.

Students enrolled in clubs will be expected to attend all club meetings (if in attendance at school that day) and use the same means of transportation home at 3:30 for the entire club session. Students must have an ASP Release Form on file. Any student not picked up immediately after a club meeting will be assigned to the After School Program and charged the daily rate.
