Task #1: Remind101

Task: Join the <u>APUSH remind 101</u> group through the link or by texting @k772bk to the number 81010

Task #2: Time period 1(1491 - 1607) Videos & Reading

Task: Watch the attached videos and read the attached chapters. Fill in the <u>guided notes</u>. <u>Assessment</u>: this will be the bulk of the quiz on the 2^{nd} day of school.

- Here is a set of "guided notes" for the videos and .pdf reading chapters to help you manage the information. *This handout is not a grade, but will help you focus on the important information (which you will be expected to have mastered on the first test).*
- Watch the Tom Richey Videos on content covered on Period 1. You need to watch the following videos. *Links below*.
 - <u>Native American Cultures, 1491-1607</u> (about 15 minutes)
 - Spanish Colonization of the Americas about 8ish minutes
 - <u>French colonization of North America</u> -about 8ish minutes
 - o <u>New Netherlands; Dutch colonization of North America</u> about 9 minutes
 - <u>English Colonization</u> (5ish minutes)
- Read the chapters, <u>"New World of Many Cultures</u>" and <u>"The Thirteen Colonies and the British Empire</u>." These are from a review book called *United States History; Preparing for the Advanced Placement Examination* (2015 edition). Do the <u>guided notes</u> *trust me*.

Best advice: Do the <u>guided notes</u> as you watch the videos and read. Again, not a grade, but very helpful for the quiz on the 2nd day of school.

Task #3: Constitutional Vocabulary.

The task: Learn the vocabulary on this flashcard deck. **Assessment**: this will be one section on the quiz on the 2nd day of school.

• <u>Constitutional Vocabulary</u> – these are words that I use all the time and assume you know. So, you'd better do the quizlet to be sure you know what I'm talking about.

Task #4: Map of the US -

Task: Learn the US map (states and selected rivers). **Assessment:** Quiz on the 3rd day of school.

• You will have to know the 50 states for this class, plus a few major land features (Appalachian and Rocky mountain ranges, Mississippi, Missouri, Rio Grande, Ohio, and St. Lawrence Rivers. For the states, I suggest googling "US Map Game" to learn them.
