



There are 3 parts to this summer work:

Part I: Period 1 (1491 - 1607) You will be <u>quizzed</u> on this on this content on the 3rd <u>day</u> of school.

- Read the chapters, "New World of Many Cultures" and "The Thirteen Colonies and the British Empire."
