Other	<p><u>Roy Raybold, BOE</u>: BOE recognized as a Board of Excellence, was a finalist for the Governance Team of the Year, received "Leading Edge" award. BOE approved refreshing chrome books for grades 3-7 immediately; 2 grades will be added on a schedule until all chrome books are switched out. "Blackboard" is being replaced with a more user-friendly system, "Schoology". \$5K approved for upgrade of band instruments. New crisis alert system for teachers in all schools where an alert button will be on badges. This will be implemented with funding from the state, not taxpayer money. Adult meal cost will increase by 35c. Athletic Department will now keep \$2 per ticket sold per game which was previously given to BOE.</p>
