Dental Insurance Plan Highlights

What Is It? Insurance to help you pay for Dental care and keep your teeth healthy! We offer four plan choices provided by Delta Dental:

Network Platinum Plan (Delta): Pays 100% of Preventive care (such as cleanings), 90% of basic services (like fillings, simple extractions, root canals, and periodontia), and 60% of major services (like crowns, bridges and dentures) to an annual maximum of \$2,000 per person.

Orthodontia expenses are covered at 50% for both children and adults to a separate lifetime maximum of \$2,000. <u>You</u> <u>MUST use a Delta Dental PPO network dentist if you select</u> <u>this plan.</u>

ChoicePlus Plan (Delta): Pays 100% of Preventive care (such as cleanings), 80% of basic services (like fillings and simple extractions), and 60% of major services (like root canals, periodontia, crowns, bridges and dentures) to an annual maximum of \$1,500 per person.

Orthodontia expenses are covered at 50% for both children and adults to a separate lifetime maximum of \$1,500. You may use any dentist in this plan, but you will save money if you use a Delta Dental PPOSM network dentist.

ChoiceStandard Plan (Delta): Pays 100% of Preventive care (such as cleanings), 80% of basic services (like fillings and simple extractions), and 50% of major services (like root canals, periodontia, crowns, bridges and dentures) to an annual maximum of \$750 per person.

Orthodontia expenses are not covered in this plan. You may use any dentist in this plan, but you will save money if you use a Delta Dental PPOSM network dentist.

DMO (Delta): This plan is designed specifically to be very low cost to join. <u>You MUST use an DeltaCare USA network</u> <u>dentist if you enroll in this plan</u>, so be sure to look up dentists in your area before you sign up.

Most preventive services, such as exams, x-rays and cleanings are covered at 100% (frequency limits apply). For everything else, you pay a fixed co-pay. The amount you pay depends on the service being performed.
