The Georgia Milestones Assessment System measures how well students have learned the knowledge and skills outlined in the state-adopted content standards in language arts, mathematics, and science (Grade 5 only). Elementary school students in grades 3 through 5 will take an end-of-grade assessment in each of the designated content areas. Your child's teacher will be providing your student with online practice navigating the assessment platform. You may also visit www.gaexperienceonline.com at home to provide additional practice opportunities.
