Minutes

New Business

- 1. Media Center Refresh
 - **a.** Committee members were invited to visit the media center and look at materials for the upcoming 'refresh' that is happening this summer (2018)
- 2. Orchestra Room Refresh
 - a. Summer of 2018 install of carpet to help with acoustics in the room
- 3. Basketball Season for 8th graders has begun
 - a. Members were invited to upcoming games
- 4. Chromebooks
 - a. Delay in the order on DELL's end
 - b. Delivery to FCBOE is expected in mid-February 2018

- c. Student roll out is expected third week in February beginning with 8th grade.
 - i. WMS will roll out one grade-level per day
- d. Mr. Jim Farmer, Chief Technology Officer for FCBOE visited the school for a faculty meeting on January 10, 2018 and then for a parent meeting in the evening on the same date
 - i. FCBOE has ordered about 11,000 Chromebooks for the county
 - ii. All Chromebooks have to be sent to a company to install the protection software
 - 1. Chromebooks will come with same safeguards and firewalls as if the student were logged onto the FCBOE wi-fi network
 - 2. Chromebooks will come in a Kevlar type case with charging cords
 - 3. WMS has decided that charging will need to be done at home
 - 4. Insurance can be purchased for approximate cost of \$25 and is good for one year with no deductible
- e. Chromebooks will stay with students throughout the summer (except the 8th graders)
 - . Underclassmen will keep the same Chromebook for the three years they attend WMS
- f. Chromebooks will be refreshed about every 3 4 years to keep up with changing technology
- g. Teachers will have a small set 3 5 of Chromebooks in the classroom for students who opt out or failed to bring theirs to class
- h. Chromebook responsibility will be tied to PBIS using Wildcat Cash
- i. Digital Citizenship Common Sense Media
 - Teachers are teaching digital citizenship using Nearpod to student twice a week during the Literacy period
 - ii. Dr. Warren is teaching two large lessons in the media center and students will change their passwords to be more secure than current passwords
- j. FCBOE technology department has put together a handbook that WMS will use as agreement between the system/school and parent/student
- k. Parents will have the option to opt-out of getting a Chromebook for their student
- 5. Activi Board Panels
 - a. Last wave of install will happen in April of 2018
 - i. Generally only the connections teachers are due to receive a board
