Mrs. Baldwin opened the meeting by thanking everyone for their attendance and participation.


Guest Speaker:


Within the presentation are student demographics, student growth, and what each school is doing that is special. The demographics for Whitewater Middle are as follows:

Whitewater Middle Total Growth Percentile Summation for 2018-2019:

- Overall improved Academic Growth on the Milestones Assessment was 66.6%.
- Largest gains in the 8th grade.
 This is to be expected since 8th grade is a cumulation of all the previous grades.
- Math is not making the same growth as ELA. Mrs. Baldwin states this is due to the enormous push through the Literacy classes to increase Literacy and Comprehension skills. We will now turn our attention to increasing the math skills during this time.



Whitewater Middle is beginning collaboration with Whitewater High to increase participation into the HOSA program. WMS is looking to add two classes (connections) for 8th grade students who are interested in the Health-Science pathway.





Whitewater Middle School is currently in its fourth year of Positive Behavior Intervention School (PBIS).
