Survey should be located on the home screen in the "Important To-Dos and Tasks" section on the homepage. **Be prepared to provide information about college applications, college decisions, scholarships you have been offered, and where you would like to have your final transcript sent electronically following graduation.** (this does not apply to DE transcripts)
- May 2 – May 19** Requests for paper copies of final transcripts will be accepted in the Guidance office May 2 - 19. The cost is \$3** per transcript. **Most colleges prefer electronic copies of final transcripts, which we send for free upon request, but you may want a paper copy for other reasons** - sorority RUSH, potential college transfers, etc. All graduate records are transferred to the county records center from which you can request transcripts if needed in the future.
