FROM THE OFFICE OF THE ADMINISTRATION:

PARKING: Additional golf cart permits will be sold on Wednesday, January 22nd beginning at 8:00 a.m. Students must complete the GREEN parking permit request completely before purchasing a permit. The cost for a golf cart permit for second semester is \$20.00. There is a limited number of spaces available which are sold on a first come first serve basis. Unfortunately, there will not be any additional car parking permits sold due to space limitations.

NAMI/ENDING THE SILENCE PRESENTATION: NAMI, Ending the Silence, will be offering a 1-hour presentation for parents and primary caregivers that includes early warning signs of mental illness, facts and statistics, and how to talk with your child. STUDENT DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP: Students should arrive on campus no earlier than 8:00 a.m. unless they have a scheduled appointment with a teacher. end of semester

Student drop-off and pick-up is in front of the gym. You may access the drop-off/pick-up lane by using the entrance closest to Peachtree Parkway. There is **NO** student drop-off or pick-up in the front parking lot.

PATHWAY REMINDER: Please be mindful to stay on the designated paths when driving your golf carts. Some area properties have requested that our students not cut through their properties when getting to other areas of the path.

OUTSIDE FAST FOOD: Please remember that only homemade lunches may be dropped off at the front office for pick up by students. Fast food lunches may NOT be delivered to the school. In addition, students should not bring containers/drinks from outside vendors during the school day. Students are allowed to drink water in a bottle or seal-able tumbler in classrooms. All other food and drink is prohibited.

CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT, AND GUEST PROCEDURES: McIntosh has a Check-in, Check-out, and Guest procedure. In order to use the new system visitors, parents and guardians need to scan a license at one of our kiosks. Please make sure to bring your license in next time you come to check-out your students or visit MHS.

FROM THE COUNTY OFFICE:

REGARDING UBER/LYFT: Anyone under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian with them when they ride in an Uber or Lyft, and car seats are required as well for small children and infants. If the Uber or Lyft driver is a relative of the student, that person should be on the contact list in IC, and the same procedures for pick up in the office or in the car line should be followed.

FROM THE COUNSELING OFFICE:

KENNESAW STATE UNIVERSITY CAMPUS TOUR: The Counseling Department is sponsoring a college visit to Kennesaw State University on Monday, February 10th. The visit will include an information session, campus tour, and lunch. The cost is \$25. This

DUAL ENROLLMENT MANDATORY INFORMATION SESSION FOR 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR: To participate in the Dual Enrollment Program for the next school year, 2020-2021, the student and parent must attend one of the Informational Sessions provided across the county. DUAL ENROLLMENT LUNCH AND LEARN SESSION: On Tuesday, January 21st and Wednesday, January 22nd the Counseling Dept. will host dual enrollment lunch and learn sessions for students to drop in and ask questions about the application process. Students are welcome to bring their lunch and attend.

ZERO PERIOD CREDIT RECOVERY: Zero Period Credit Recovery will be offered at MHS from 7:30 a.m.–8:20 a.m. on Tuesday & Thursday mornings this semester. In order to be eligible for this program, students need to have earned a minimum of 55 in the course. In lieu of the previously advertised parent/student mandatory meeting, the student must attend a lunch and learn meeting instead on Tuesday, January 28th OR Wednesday, January 29th in the Counseling Office during their assigned lunch period (students may bring their lunch to the meeting) in order to be eligible for this program. Instructions and forms will be given to students during this session. Zero Period Credit Recovery begins on February 11th, and the course must be completed by May 2nd.

SOUTHERN CRESCENT TECHNICAL COLLEGE CAREER EXPLORATION DAY: The Southern Crescent Technical College Career Exploration Day will be Friday, February 28th. This meeting will be open to juniors and seniors interested in pursuing their post-secondary education at SCTC. Students will be given a brief overview of SCTC, a campus tour, a chance to talk to program representatives, and a chance to submit applications (fee waived).
