## **Treasure Report:**

LeAnne S. discussed the 2019-2020 budget. So far, we have broke even with the agenda sales. Not every student has paid for one, but each student has been supplied with one. PTO fees paid this year so far are \$21,539. Paid agendas are at \$3,745, and locker fees are at \$4,155.

Our reconciled cash balance - general account amount is at \$33,847.70 Our total expenses + account balance is at \$40,934.57.

### **School Programs:**

Kelly K. updated us on the school programs. Popcorn sales currently at \$40, usually between \$50-60 this time of year, so we are a little under. More popcorn training is scheduled, some volunteers signed up but did not show up to train. Every Wednesday is scheduled to sell popcorn.

Ice cream sales are doing well. Kids respond well to both ice cream and popcorn sales.

### **Spirit Wear:**

Amy T. updated us about Spirit Wear. The first order is set to be delivered to the teachers this Friday. There will be one more order placed this year - tentatively October 4/5.

Liah Lopez updated us on the dance. The theme will be New York this year. We have it scheduled for a Saturday to make it easier to decorate and prepare. Liah plans to add a few more pieces this year and recycle as much as she can for the following years' dance. The DJ is providing a "snow machine" for one hour of the dance to look like Christmas in NY. This "snow" is soap that will dissolve before it hits the ground, so there will be no issues with damaging school property.
