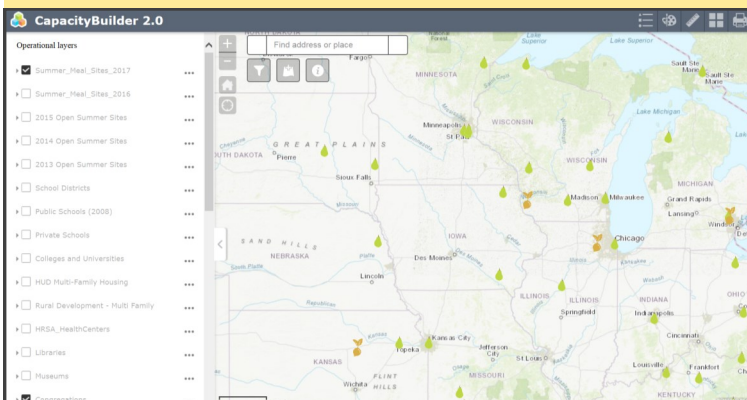
What's New: FNS's Official Texting Number 97779

This upcoming summer, FNS is debuting a new text number. Folks can text "**Summer Meals**" to 97779 to find 2018 Summer sites. This FNS text number is an additional tool that families can use to find Summer sites. Sponsors are welcome to promote which ever number that is most convenient for them.

In addition to the texting number, FNS also has a [Summer Meals Site Finder website](#) that families can use to locate summer meals site throughout the county. Please note that site information for 2018 will start becoming available in early May.

FNS Tool Spotlight!

The [Capacity Builder](#) allow users to visualize "layers" of information, such as the area eligibility data, existing sites and potential site locations (multi-family housing units, libraries, museums, and schools and more). The Capacity Builder is a powerful tool for State agencies and sponsors to evaluate previous summer's performance as well as identify areas where there are gaps in summer meal access.
